DATA DISSEMINATION AND PRICING POLICY 1995

The County of Oxford will make its data available in digital and printed formats from the Land Related Information System.

The County of Oxford will respect all licence agreements, verbal or written, which relate to the ownership of data received from outside agencies.

The County of Oxford will continue to negotiate with outside agencies to determine the share (if any) of Oxford's data which is owned by outside agencies.

The County of Oxford will respect all legislation such as the Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act (MFOIPPA), and the Ministry of Finance Confidentiality of Information under the Assessment Act and any other legislation or policy respecting access to information.

The County of Oxford will respect the intent of the Planning Reform Act (Bill 163) which endorses the availability of data.

The County of Oxford will provide data specific to a property on a property-by-property basis to the owner or a potential owner of the subject property free of charge or for a "reasonable" price when access is in keeping with the Department's mandate.

The County of Oxford will provide data for a "fair" price, subject to a licence agreement for single end users of the data.

The County of Oxford will publish a pricing schedule which clearly sets out the price to be charged for "standard products", and a pricing guideline for "custom" requests. The pricing schedule will be updated periodically to reflect new products, and to remain current with market values and data agreements.

The County of Oxford will respond to requests in a timely manner, given current staffing levels and commitments.

The County of Oxford may waive or discount fees for certain uses of the data, such as non-profit research.
