PURPOSE:

The provide direction to staff in fire prevention and fire emergency response. Adherence to the fire safety plans will reduce the probability of a fire occurring and ensure the safety of all residents, employees and visitors while minimizing property damage in the event of a fire emergency.

POLICY:

Staff shall comply with the provisions of the approved fire safety plan for each facility.

PROCEDURE:

Management in consultation with the Joint Occupational Health & Safety Committee shall ensure that a fire safety plan is developed and updated as required for each facility. Fire safety plans shall include provisions for the following:

- 1. Information outlining building and human resources
- 2. Responsibilities
- 3. Emergency Procedures
- 4. Fire Drill Procedures
- 5. Fire Checks / Nightly Fire Rounds
- 6. Staff Training
- 7. Control of Fire Hazards
- 8. Maintenance requirements
- 9. Building and site schematics
